






- Teacher Chaperones- many who have done this trip for 10+ years.

Other Tidbits



- Bus ride
 - 1 morning and afternoon ride to DC and hotel that evening
 - 1 night we sleep on the bus on the way home
 - Kids can bring snacks and water
- Hotel
 - 3 total nights at a Crowne Plaza (Hotel can change but we have stayed there a few times recently)
 - A pool is sometimes available/Gathering Room
 - Dance and DJ another night
- Souvenir shopping- for reasonably priced items.
- We are on the go from 7AM- 8 PM each day. There is so much to see. We encourage eating well and getting rest when they can!

Meals





- Places vary year to year be we take great pride in offering meals that are fueling and tasty. Kids are encouraged to bring snacks and water for the bus ride.
- We try to find places that are kid-friendly and can also accommodate large groups.
- Some places we have done in the past for dinner: Pizzeria Uno, Chevy's (Tex Mex), Italian restaurants, Champps, etc.
- Some places we have done in the past for lunch: Food court at Union Station or Regan International Trade Center, and Roy Rogers.
- Breakfast will be a buffet at the hotel in a banquet room.

Medicine & Procedures

- We will send home a medical form that must be completed from World Strides. The more detailed you are-the better. Students have many different allergies, but their effects vary greatly.
- Also, it is important to have a conversation with your child about how to communicate their allergy or health issues. They will need to be able to select food on their own and make choices that won't harm them. They need to independently handle their allergy/medical issue.
- We also will have a form to complete if your child takes medicine. We will ask that you complete the form and submit it along with your child meds in snack baggies labeled per day and time to take. Then place all of the snack baggies in a sandwich bag. This makes it easy to carry and to distribute.
- Students must carry their own EpiPen and inhalers.
- A chaperone on each bus takes charge of all meds for the bus. They should know and see that person at breakfast or other times they need the medicine.
- We have nut free busses. However, we do not inspect what students bring.

Showcase the Program Experience

- Registration Information- will be shared via Schoology to all students through their social studies classes.
- Information is also located on the Smith website under trips. As we get new information it is also updated. Keep in mind we will start sharing information about the Fall 2022 trip for current 7th graders in November. Be sure to read information for Feb. 2022.
- We also send communication through the Knightly News and eblast. Be sure to check them out.



- Final Payment is due by December 5, 2021.




