- You may begin to set up at 5:30 after signing in electronically. Plan on cleaning your area before you leave for the night. Each booth will have two card tables and several chairs. You may be sharing this space with other students. We will cover the tables with paper and put up a sign and flag.
- Have food that can be purchased with tickets to benefit local charity. Suggested price-\$.25-\$1.00, depending on serving size. We will provide the price tags, or you can make your own. The tickets will be sold at the door - you will not need to handle money. We will have ticket boxes for you and a glove for serving. You will have access to a microwave oven.
- Students will be visiting each booth and will receive a stamp in their passport to get E.C.,
  if approved by teacher. We will provide the stamps.

## Possible items you will need for the Festival:
